2. (a) Briefly describe any four inner forms of the library catalogue. [10]
(b) What is Dublin Core (DC)? Explain the Dublin Core elements with examples. [1+9]
3. (a) Discuss the purpose of MARC21? Write with examples of MARC Tag, Indicators, Subfield, delimiter. [2 + 8]
(b) Describe the core concepts and entities within the Functional Requirements for Bibliographic Records (FRBR) model. Explain how FRBR restructures catalog databases to reflect the conceptual structure of information resources and provide examples of relationships between Group 1 and Group 2 entities. Elaborate on the significance of attributes in FRBR and their role in supporting user tasks and enhancing bibliographic records. [4 + 3 + 3]
4. (a) Discuss the concept of metadata and its significance in organizing and accessing information resources. Provide examples of how metadata supports user tasks and explain how it aids in the identification, description, and location of resources. [4 + 6]
(b) What is Metadata schema? Discuss the significance of metadata schemas in different domains, such as cultural heritage, research information, education, and data cataloging. Explain the role of each standard in its respective domain and how it contributes to the organization and accessibility of data or resources. [2 + 4 + 4]
