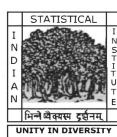

Visiting Scientist positions at Stat-Math Unit Indian Statistical Institute, Bangalore

[NOTE (dated 24 June 2020): We will not be able to support new postdoctoral candidates for the running academic year. However, we still invite applications from candidates supported by external funding agencies.]

The Theoretical Statistics and Mathematics Unit of ISI-Bangalore invites applications for Visiting Scientist/Post-Doctoral positions in Mathematics and Statistics through the year. These are research positions for up to six months, with possibilities of further extensions after a review.

The position may involve some nominal teaching related duties (e.g. tutorship, invigilation work, grading/teaching).

Offers for the Visiting positions will be made 4 times a year. The deadlines for submission of applications for each quarter are December 15, May 15, July 15 and September 15.

Selected candidates will be informed via email. If they would like to take up the position they will need to indicate their acceptance within a week from the date of the offer, and join the institute no later than a month from the date of the offer.

Eligibility: Ph.D. from a recognized Institute/University. Candidates who have freshly submitted their Ph.D. thesis are also encouraged to apply.

Candidates with post-doctoral fellowships from external funding agencies (e.g. NBHM, CSIR, DST etc.) and INSPIRE faculty fellowships are also eligible. The tenure of such fellowships/positions will be governed by the norms of the funding agency. The application must include supporting documents for the award of the fellowship.

Documents: Along with the application, the candidates must also include the following documents in a ZIP file: (1) CV with a list of publications, if any. (2) A write up of work already done along with a plan for future work, and (3) Soft copy of Ph.D. thesis, and preprints/reprints, if any.

Along with the application, candidates should also include the CV, list of publications, the names of referees - if possible in ISI-Bangalore.

Also please arrange recommendation letters from two referees (one from the supervisor, in case of fresh Ph.D.) familiar with applicant's research work, to be sent directly by the referees to the Head, Stat-Math-Unit, ISI-Bangalore at the email id **`jaydeb AT gmail DOT com`**
