- (1) Let D be the set of all sequences $\{a_n\}_{n \in \mathbb{N}}$ where $a_n \in \{1, 2, 3\}$ for all $n \in \mathbb{N}$, $\lim_{n \rightarrow \infty} a_n$ exists. Show that D is countable. [15]
- (2) Suppose $\{x_n\}_{n \in \mathbb{N}}$ and $\{y_n\}_{n \in \mathbb{N}}$ are convergent sequences of real numbers and

$$\lim_{n \rightarrow \infty} x_n = \lim_{n \rightarrow \infty} y_n.$$

Show that the sequence $\{z_n\}_{n \in \mathbb{N}}$ defined by

$$z_n = \begin{cases} x_n & \text{if } n \text{ is odd;} \\ y_n & \text{if } n \text{ is even.} \end{cases}$$

is convergent and

$$\lim_{n \rightarrow \infty} z_n = \lim_{n \rightarrow \infty} x_n.$$

- (3) Determine limsup and liminf of the following sequences of real numbers.

(i)

$$\{5 + (-\frac{1}{2})^n \cdot 7 : n \in \mathbb{N}\}.$$

(ii)

$$\{\frac{n}{4^n} - \frac{n}{5^n} : n \in \mathbb{N}\}.$$

(iii)

$$\{3 - \frac{2n-1}{n^2+1} : n \in \mathbb{N}\}.$$

- (4) Show that the function $g : (0, 2) \rightarrow \mathbb{R}$ defined by

$$g(x) = \frac{3}{x}, \quad x \in (0, 2)$$

is not uniformly continuous. [15]

- (5) Suppose $h : [0, 1] \rightarrow [0, 1]$ is a continuous function satisfying

$$h(t)h(1-t) \leq 0, \quad \forall t \in [0, \frac{1}{2}).$$

Show that $h(\frac{1}{2}) = 0$. [15]

- (6) Suppose $u : [-1, 1] \rightarrow \mathbb{R}$ and $v : [-1, 1] \rightarrow \mathbb{R}$ are functions, and $m : [-1, 1] \rightarrow \mathbb{R}$ is defined by

$$m(x) = \max\{u(x), v(x)\}, \quad x \in [-1, 1]$$

(i) Show that if u, v are continuous then m is continuous. (ii) Give an example to show that u, v are differentiable does not imply that m is differentiable. [15]

- (7) Suppose $f : [0, 1] \rightarrow \mathbb{R}$ is a non-constant differentiable function and $f(0) = f(1)$. Show that there exist s, t in $(0, 1)$ such that $f'(s) < 0$ and $f'(t) > 0$. [15]
